Kleindal Chenin Blanc  **£20.00**
 Robertson Valley, South Africa
 250ml £7.00
 175ml £5.25
 Tropical fruit salad aromas and a zesty fresh palate which is light bodied and easy drinking with a crisp finish.

Pinot Grigio Venezia DOC  **£22.00**
 Veneto, Italy
 250ml £7.75
 175ml £5.75
 A pleasant, balanced, harmonious and fruity wine of good structure with floral notes and hints of pear and apricot – 100% Pinot Grigio.

Bon Courage Chardonnay Unwooded  **£23.00**
 Robertson Valley, South Africa
 250ml £8.00
 175ml £6.50
 Unoaked Chardonnay from Robertson Valley in South Africa, this has a very inviting nose with an unctuous palate of stone fruit with a clean acidity and long pure finish as this wine has seen no oak.

La Serre Picpoul de Pinet AOP  **£25.00**
 Languedoc, France
 Clear in colour with green tints, it offers a fresh bouquet with citrus fruit notes complemented by a heady aroma and a crisp, refreshing palate.

Cool Mountain Sauvignon Blanc **£26.00**
 Western Cape, South Africa
 250ml £8.75
 175ml £7.00
 Crisp, fresh and aromatic with concentrated flavours of gooseberry, passion fruit and zesty citrus, ripe acidity and great balance and harmony.

Gavi di Gavi DOCG  **£30.00**
 Piedmont, Italy
 An enticing nose of white peach and pear with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry. Fresh and zesty citrus notes and ripe peachy characters are balanced by crisp acidity and mineral notes – leading to a textural, complex finish.

Chapel Down Flint Dry **£32.00**
 Tenterden, Kent
 Dry, fresh and floral on the palate with crisp aromas of ripe apple, grass and citrus zest.

Mount Riley Sauvignon Blanc **£35.00**
 Marlborough, New Zealand
 Vibrant aromas & flavours of lime zest, gooseberries and currants with a touch of herbal infusion, a weighty mouthfeel and crisp acidity.

L'Onciale Chablis AC **£38.00**
 Bourgogne, France
 Distinctly nutty with grilled nuts, toasted chestnuts and citrus fresh lemon acidity.

Sancerre Le Chene du Roy **£40.00**
 Loire Valley, France
 This Sauvignon Blanc has a golden hue and an expressive citrus fruit nose which is unique in its minerality, finesse and freshness. To finish, the palate is fruit-driven revealing citrus aromas whilst maintaining the roundness typical of its distinct terroir.

RED WINES

Pierre Lacasse Cabernet Sauvignon **£19.00**
 Pays D'Oc, France
 250ml £6.50
 175ml £5.00
 Delicious cassis fruit with a slight smokiness. A full, well structured palate with gripping tannins on the finish.

Y Knot Tempranillo  **£20.00**
 Vino De La Tierra De Castilla, Spain
 250ml £7.00
 175ml £5.25
 Bright cherry red in colour with powerful aromas of ripe, red fruits and a smooth, silky palate.

Tempus Two Merlot  **£22.00**
 South Eastern Australia
 250ml £7.75
 175ml £5.75
 A rich, soft and smooth wine with dark berry and plum fruit characters. The palate is packed with ripe raspberry notes, fine grained tannins and subtle hints of oak.

Old Station Malbec **£23.00**
 Mendoza, Argentina
 250ml £8.00
 175ml £6.50
 A well balanced, rich wine with lush fruit flavours of boysenberry and blackberry and aromas of toast, mineral and spice and a vibrant acidity.

RED WINES contd.

Darriaud Cotes Du Rhone Villages **£26.00**
 Rhone Valley, France
 Aromas of bramble fruits with warm spice. Bold, fruit driven – again ripe bramble fruits with spice and soft vanilla oak. Smooth well integrated tannins that hold the fruit flavours to a lovely long finish with plenty of depth and body.

Bon Courage Pepper Tree Shiraz **£28.00**
 Robertson Valley, South Africa
 Ripe red berry fruit, reminiscent of spicy plum jam, is complemented by pepper and vanilla, a full, rounded palate and soft tannins.

11th Hour Cellars Pinot Noir **£30.00**
 California, USA
 Sandy loam soil produces intensely flavoured fruit which is handpicked giving raspberry and black cherry fruit flavours with soft tannins and a very smooth finish.

Manoso Reserva Rioja     **£35.00**
 Rioja, Spain
 Deep ruby in colour with aromas of black and red forest fruits and subtle vanilla. These marry on the palate with subtle cocoa and black pepper spice. Perfect balance between freshness and acidity, with integrated, mellow tannins.

Chateau du Val d'Or **£40.00**
 Saint-Émilion Bordeaux, France
 The nose is fine and expressive, evoking black fruits and roasted almonds. When swirled, the style is delicate with smoked and burnt aromas, enhanced by marzipan. The attack is pure and powerful, with black fruit flavours and a hint of spices (pepper, nutmeg and cinnamon.)

Nittardi Ad Astra DOC **£45.00**
 Maremma Toscana, Italy
 An expressive, elegant, medium bodied wine with aromas of plums, berries and a hint of liquorice, fine tannins and a fresh, clean finish.

Chateau Beauchene Chateaufeuf du Pape AC **£48.00**
 Rhone, France
 A rich wine produced from Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre wine grapes, vinified in stainless steel tank and aged 70% in neutral oak barriques and 30% in stainless steel for one year prior to release. Beautifully rich on the nose with ripe dark cherry, red berry and savoury herb aromas, vibrant on the palate.
